## **The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy**

(for recitation on ordinary Rosary beads)

**Begin with** *the Sign of the Cross, Our Father..., Hail Mary...,  
and The Apostles' Creed.*

**Then, on the "Our Father" beads you say the following:**

*Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity  
of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins  
and those of the whole world.*

**On the "Hail Mary" beads you say the following:**

*For the sake of His Sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us  
and on the whole world.*

**Finally, replace the "Glory Be" spaces by reciting three times the following:**

*Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us  
and on the whole world.*

**End the "5 Decade" Chaplet with** *the Sign of the Cross.*
